

GEORGIAN COLLEGE BOARD OF GOVERNORS SEEKS NEW RECRUITS

GEORGIAN seeks applications from persons interested in assisting the college's Board of Governors to achieve its mission, "to inspire innovation, transform lives and connect communities through the power of education." There are three positions available with a term to commence Sept. 1, 2023. The positions consist of a three-year term with eligibility for a second term of three years.

The appointment is voluntary. To be eligible to serve on the board, applicants must have an understanding of, and interest in, education and training issues and linkages to the labour market, good interpersonal and communication skills, and should have demonstrated service and leadership in their place of employment, and/or through community involvement.

Desirable assets of a Georgian board member:

- Prior board experience (corporate or volunteer)
- Understanding of government relations and strategic planning
- Background in business or automotive sector
- Interest in pursuing philanthropic support for the college
- Understanding of, and willingness to commit to, attendance and time expectations of the board

In order to complement existing members of the board, we are seeking one new governor from the Orangeville area.

We ask that governors commit to attendance expectations (there are eight board meetings per year), committee work, and participate in college and community events as required. Georgian College supports diversity, equity and a workplace free from harassment and discrimination and is committed to an inclusive, barrier-free environment. We invite applications from all qualified candidates and actively encourage applications from members of groups with historical and/or current barriers to equity, including, but not limited to persons of Indigenous ancestry, racialized persons, persons with disabilities, women and members of the 2SLGBTQ+ community.
